

Market demands in the Eastern Townships

Hi, my name is Jessica Girard and I am a guidance counsellor with Job Links, the employment/guidance counselling resource for the adult anglophone population of the Eastern Townships. My primary focus is employment and guidance counselling where I guide clients as well as provide them with tools and resources to help them integrate into the job market or identify a professional goal. In both types of services, it's important for my clients to be aware of the current market demands in the region as this may have a direct influence on the choices they make.

As of 2019, most jobs were found in the secondary sector (transformation of raw material into products or goods) and tertiary sector (services) (Ministère du Travail, de l'Emploi et de la Solidarité sociale). In fact, about 1 in every 5 jobs were in the industrial sector and 7 in 10 jobs were in the service sector¹. In this region, our secondary sector includes the manufacturing of rubber, plastic, metal and wood products as well as transportation material. On the other hand, our tertiary sector includes the field of education, the retail and wholesale trade sector, the restaurant industry and the health care and social assistance sector.

Of course, the current pandemic has had a direct impact on the job opportunities in the sectors. On one hand, from November to December 2020, for the whole of Quebec, there has been decreases in various sectors, such as in the health care and social assistance sector and the accommodation and food services sector (Ministère du Travail, de l'Emploi et de la Solidarité sociale, 2021). However, there has also been an increase, in the professional, scientific and technical services sector, the retail and wholesale trade sector and the manufacturing sector.
